

# How to spend 5 days in Hamburg

## DAY 1:



- Arrival in **Hamburg**, transfer to hotel and check in
- Relax and discover the city center or enjoy a walk in the Alster lake area

## DAY 2: “Hamburg Basics”



- Individual **sightseeing tour** (hop on-hop off, company Rote Doppeldecker) or a guided one with Arabic speaking guide  
(tickets for hop on- hop off: € 17,50 for adults, children up to 14 accompanied by parents are free of charge)
- **Alster lake cruise** for either 1 hour or 2 hours which includes beautiful and romantic water canals  
(ticket prices: € 15 for adults, € 7,50 for children up to 16 years, € 37,50 for families 2 adults plus 4 children)
- **Harbor cruise** (1 hour)  
(ticket prices: adults € 18, children 5 – 14 years € 9, children below 4 free)
- Make your first **shopping** experiences in exquisite shopping arcades, malls or department stores

### **DAY 3:** “Hamburg for families”



Choose from the big variety inside the city centre like:

- **MiniaturWunderland** the world's biggest model railway exhibition  
(Ticket prices: adults € 13, children € 6,50)
- Rent a sailing boat incl. a skipper and **sail the Alster lake**
- **CHOCOVERSUM** chocolate museum  
(Ticket prices: adults € 14, children 6-17 years € 10)
- **PROTOTYP** museum - presenting some 40 classic sports cars and automobiles of an extreme rarity, with a special emphasis on Porsche designs  
(Ticket prices: adults € 9, children 4-14 years € 4,50, family ticket for 2 adult and 3 children € 20)
- **Hamburg Dungeon** - actors will have you immersed in a realistic reconstruction of the past – provoking plenty of goose bumps, exciting surprises and scary moments  
(Ticket prices: adults € 25, children 10-14 years € 20,50, online tickets start at € 15,50 for adults and € 14,50 for children)
- Hamburg Zoo **Hagenbeck's**  
(Ticket prices: adults € 20, children 4-16 years € 15, family tickets available)
- Enjoy the **beaches in Hamburg** and watch the big cruise or container ships coming into Hamburg's harbor
- Fun Festival **DOM** with roller coasters, Ferris wheel and many rides for every age  
Timing 2015: 20.03. – 19.04., 24.07. – 23.08. and 06.11. – 06.12  
Wednesdays is family day: reduced fees for rides and food and don't miss the big firework every Friday night 10:30 p.m.

**DAY 4: “Hamburg for families”**

Option 1:

Full day trip to **Heide-Park Soltau** (1 hour away by car)  
Heide-Park Soltau is always a great day out for all age groups. It has the steepest wooden roller coaster in the world, a pirates' world action comedy show and plenty other rides the whole family can enjoy.

(Ticket prices: adults € 45, children 4 – 11 years € 37, reduced fares for online-tickets prior to arrival)



Option 2:

Full day trip to **Serengeti Safari Park** (1,5 hours away by car)  
Germany's biggest safari and big game reserve features over 1,000 exotic animals. You can see giraffes, rhinos, camels and many other animals at first hand on the safari road through the animal enclosures.

(Ticket prices: adults € 29, children 3 – 12 years € 24)



Option 3:

Full day trip to **HANSA PARK** (1 hour away by car)  
Enjoy a ride on the world's highest flying carousel which is only one of more than 35 rides at HANSA PARK. You can also enjoy fantastic entertainment like the sea lion show.

(Ticket prices: adults € 35, children 4 – 14 years € 28)

## **DAY 5:** “Hamburg’s surrounding”

### Option 1:

Full day excursion to **Helgoland Island** (9 am – 8.15 pm)  
Enjoy a proper breeze of North Sea air on a day trip with the catamaran from the Port of Hamburg!  
The mighty red bunter rock with green land rises out of the sea and presents itself with singular flora and fauna and mild climate supported by the near Gulf Stream.  
(Ticket prices: adults € 76, children 4 – 14 years € 38, family ticket for 2 adults plus 2 children € 185)



### Option 2:

Half or full day trip to the Baltic health resort **Travemünde**  
The white sandy beach and the fresh sea breeze attract thousands of holidaymakers to the health resort of Travemünde. The promenade is one of the most popular places in Germany to take a walk.

### Option 3:

Shopping at **McArthurGlen Designer Outlet Neumünster**
